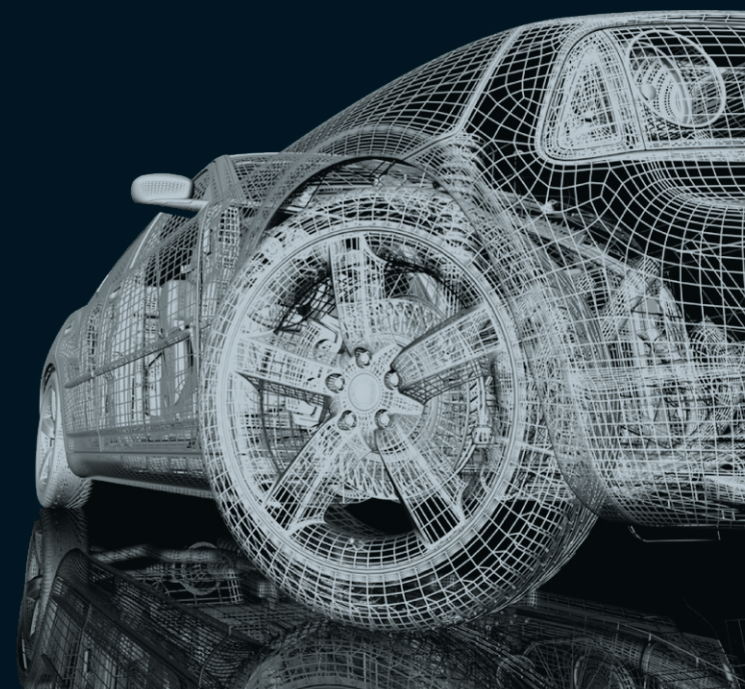

ALLOY WHEEL PROTECTION

- Damage caused by a third party for general maintenance.
- Commercial vehicles.
